

New Jersey Transportation Chief Says She Would Take the Ferry

New Jersey Transportation Commissioner Diane Gutierrez-Scaccetti tells media that she would use the Hudson Bergen Light Rail to a ferry as the best way to avoid the anticipated traffic delays on Route 495.

If Gutierrez-Scaccetti had to make the commute, she said her preference to driving Route 495 would be taking a Hudson Bergen Light rail train to a Hudson River ferry, rather than sit in backed up traffic.
