













What is Allowed on the NY Waterway Ferry?

Guide for E-bikes & Mobility Devices

TYPE	DESCRIPTION	BRING ON FERRY?
Bicycles 	Regular pedal-only bikes	YES
Folding Bikes 	Bikes that fold and can be held like a suitcase	YES
E-Bikes Class 1 	Low-speed, pedal assisted electric bikes - 20MPH	YES
E-Bikes Class 2 	Low-speed throttle-assisted electric bikes - 20MPH	YES
E-Bikes Class 3 	Speed pedal-assisted electric bikes - 25MPH	YES
E-Scooters 	Devices with handlebars a floorboard or seat - powered by battery or human - 15MPH	YES

The following mobility devices are not allowed on the Ferry

Motorcycles/ Gas Scooters 	Any GAS powered device - any mobility device requiring an operator's license or registration	NO
Mopeds Class C 	Limited use Motorcycles - 20MPH	NO
Mopeds Class B 	Limited Use Motorcycles - 30MPH	NO
Mopeds Class A 	Limited Use Motorcycles - 40MPH	NO
Electric Skateboards 	Battery powered skateboards	NO
Segways 	Motorized personal vehicles consisting of two wheels mounted side by side beneath a platform that the rider stands on while holding on to handlebars	NO

Charging of any E-bike or other mobility device (lithium) battery is prohibited on-board the Ferry
