Ferries from Weehawken, Hoboken, and Jersey City offer frequent service seven days a week to the West 39<sup>th</sup> Street Midtown Ferry Terminal which is right across the street from the Javits Center. Ferries have reduced fares on weekends. Weekday service from Edgewater and from Belford/Middletown is also available.

For those who would rather not do the short walk to the show entrance, free connecting NY Waterway shuttles are waiting at the West 39<sup>th</sup> Street Midtown Ferry Terminal to take customers on the short ride to the Javits Center entrance.

Several New Jersey terminals offer inexpensive parking (some free) and are served by the Hudson/Bergen Light Rail, NJ TRANSIT buses and local free NY Waterway buses.
